The **Zomato Excellence Award for Food Writing (Books)** went to Saeed Koranne-Khandekar for *Pangat – A Feast (Hachette India)* while the **Zomato Excellence Award for Food Writing (Essays)** went to Sharanya Deepak for her essay: *This Land Is Meant Only for Saffron. Without It, It Means Nothing*, published by Eater.

and Fine Chef of the Year. Chef Rahul Gomes Pereira was presented with the **The Singleton Unconventional Chef of the Year** award.
